Keep your home maintenance up and keep the bill costs down!

Get your mind in the gutters

Inspect and clean gutters and downspouts to help prevent ice damming and costly water damage issues.

Seal the deal and save for real

Seal gaps and cracks around windows and doors with weather-stripping and caulk.

Keepin it warm by putting in the storms

One of the simplest ways to save big this winter is by remembering to pull out those screens and put those storm windows to work.

Inspect your roof for damaged or curled shingles, corroded flashing, or leaky vents. Again, this can help prevent more costly damage caused by water entering your home.

Cracks in sidewalks and driveways can be hazardous. Have both inspected before the icy season arrives and you just may save yourself a good chunk of change.

Don't forget to open and drain outdoor faucets before they freeze and possibly cause the pipes to crack. (This is probably the simplest and most overlooked maintenance item on the list.)
